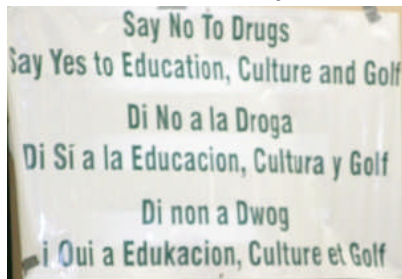




## *Inner City Youth Golfers' Incorporated*
