Day 1: FACTS ON DRUGS - MARIJUANA

OBJECTIVES: Students will be able to:

- 1. Explain what is marijuana and what are the many names for it.
- 2. Explain how it is used.
- 3. Demonstrate general skills of the writing process.

MATERIALS:

Marijuana information article for students/teacher

"TALKING ABOUT MARIJUANA IN THE CLASSROOM" article (teacher reference)

Decision-Making Vignettes

K-W-L Chart

Composition Notebook

ACTIVITIES:

Students start writing on K-W-L chart on (K column) what they KNOW about marijuana and (W column) What they WANT to find out.

Review Vocabulary Words and complete word work activity. (Write words and definitions in composition notebook)

Read and discuss marijuana information article "Facts on Drugs: Marijuana" with students.

In groups of 2 discuss how to make decisions using "Decision-Making Vignettes" - - As a whole group discuss the decisions made.

ASSESSMENT:

Ask students to write on a sheet of paper a brief essay (two paragraphs or more) of a situation when they had to make a decision. What was the result of their decision? (Turn in essay to teacher)

Complete K-W-L chart – (L column)- What did I learn?
