Day 2: FACTS ON DRUGS - MARIJUANA

OBJECTIVES: Students will be able to:

- 1. Explain how marijuana affects your mind.
- 2. Explain the common effects of marijuana use on: schoolwork, one's relationship with others, including parents; and future hopes and dreams.
- 3. Demonstrate general skills of the writing process.

MATERIALS:

Marijuana information article for students/teacher

"TALKING ABOUT MARIJUANA IN THE CLASSROOM" article (teacher reference)

K-W-L Chart

Composition Notebook

ACTIVITIES:

Students start writing on K-W-L chart on (K column) what they KNOW about the effects of marijuana on the mind and (W column) What they WANT to find out about the effects of marijuana on the mind.

Review Vocabulary Words and complete word work activity. (Using the previous day words, create a crossword puzzle in composition notebook and give to a classmate to solve.)
